Big News!

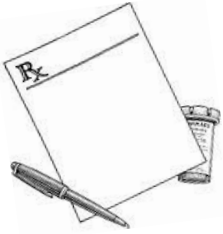

Ordering Prescriptions

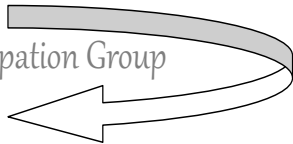
You can order a prescription in the following ways:

Please note – We are no longer taking prescription requests at the counter.

- **By phone** :Between 10.00am and 2.00pm only
- **In the surgery**: There is a prescription request box that you can use whilst the surgery is open.
- **System Online** : If you are not already registered to our online services and would like to be, please bring in photo id, such as your passport or driving licence for us to take a copy of.
- **By post**: This can be done by using the counterfoil on your last prescription. Just tick the items you need and post it to us. If you enclose a stamped addressed envelope we will be happy to post your prescription out to you.
- **Your local pharmacist** :May offer a service where they can collect and deliver your prescriptions for you. Talk to them about this free service.

It is your responsibility to order your medication. Please allow at least 48 hours for us to do your repeat prescriptions. Please be aware that we will not give out prescriptions to anyone without patient's consent
